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9-1-1 Heroes Award Program Awarded on April 16, 2018 Paragon Resort & Casino Marksville, Louisiana

Purpose:

The primary purpose of the Louisiana APCO and NENA 9-1-1 Heroes Award program is to recognize and reward a youth who has demonstrated the knowledge of the proper use of 9-1-1 by performing some heroic action during the course of the emergency/call and to promote public education and awareness of 9-1-1. Heroes must meet the following criteria developed by the Louisiana APCO and NENA Heroes Committee. If these criteria are met, the youth selected by the committee will receive the 9-1-1 Hero Award.

Criteria for Youth:

- 1. Heroic event must be ongoing or have occurred during the period January 1, 2017 December 31, 2017.
- 2. The 9-1-1 call must be self-initiated by the child and/or either the child followed pre-arrival instructions, or performed some other heroic act.
- 3. The youth must have performed some heroic action in the course of the emergency that contributed to:
 - Saving a life.
 - Significantly reducing property loss.
 - Apprehending a criminal and or stopping a crime.
- 4. The program recognizes youth ages 16 or younger; however, exceptions may be considered under special circumstances.
- 5. The agency submitting the nomination should complete the hero nomination form, including a summary of the incident/event. An audio recording of the 9-1-1 call must accompany the nomination form. All nomination information must be typed, not hand written. *Please include various 4" x 6" photos of your nominee*.
- 6. It will be the responsibility of the nominating agency to contact the child's family and invite them to the awards banquet. The youth receiving the award must be available for an interview by the committee prior to the banquet. Preferably the night before. For the interview, please contact: Don Smith at 318-245-2859.
